Call a hotline anytime.

In the event that a relative, friend or someone you know discloses that they have experienced sexual violence, the most important things you can do are:

- ▶ **Listen:** Don't just use your ears—use your eyes, face and body to show that you are listening.
- ▶ **Validate:** Do not question the survivor's story and do not blame them for what happened.
- ▶ **Inform:** Provide information about services that can help the survivor make a decision for him/herself as to what he/she should do.
